Dear Skaters & Coaches,

Skate Canada Saskatchewan has announced the 2010 Sask Skate Invitational and Open Singles Competition. The competition will be held in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan, October 8-10, 2010. The technical package for the competition is attached.

The "Sask Skate Invitational Competition" is for competitors selected by each section. The "Sask Skate Open Singles Competition" is open to any skater from each region. If you are a skater who is interested in representing Manitoba at the 2010 Sask Skate Invitational Competition, you will be required to submit the following to the Skate Canada Manitoba office by **Friday, August 20 at 11:00 am by email at skate.pc@sportmanitoba.ca or fax by at 925-5924:**

- Letter indicating you are interested in representing Manitoba for the Sask Skate Invitational Competition, along with the category that you will be competing in.
- In the letter please provide your intent for the upcoming 2010-11 skating season that includes: the competitions you are planning to attend and the event categories for each of those competitions.
- Attached to the letter you will be required to submit a report card from a 2010 Summer Competition.

The following categories will be offered at the Sask Skate Invitational Competition and will be selected by the Skate Canada Manitoba Section:

- Pre-Juvenile Ladies
- Juvenile Ladies
- Pre-Novice Ladies
- Novice Ladies
- Junior Ladies
- All Men's, Senior Ladies, Dance and Special Olympic events are Open categories.

Skaters who are interested in the Pre-Juvenile and Juvenile events are encouraged to submit a letter of interested to the selection committee even if they are not attending a 2010 summer competition. Skate Canada Manitoba has a selection committee in place that will be reviewing all submitted letters and will be selecting the team to represent Manitoba at the 2010 SGI Sask Skate Invitational Competition by Monday August 30, 2010.
