



2011-2012 CanSkate Development & Delivery CLINICS

What is the CanSkate Development and Delivery Clinic?

The CanSkate Development and Delivery Clinics are for PA's, Coaches and Club Executive who assist in the delivery of the CanSkate Program in their club. These clinics provide an opportunity to develop teaching methods and program delivery techniques to enhance existing CanSkate Programs and at the same time ensure that the program is being delivered according to the National Standards. The CanSkate Development and Delivery Clinic is an optional program for your Club. The clinician will be in contact with your club coach PRIOR to the clinician to build a plan for the day of the clinic that is very specific to your club.

Who leads the CanSkate Development and Delivery Clinics?

Skate Canada Manitoba has approved CanSkate Development and Delivery Clinicians, their bios and contact information is on the Skate Canada Manitoba's website. If you have any questions PLEASE don't hesitate to contact the Clinicians directly.

Where are the CanSkate Development and Delivery Clinics held?

Every Skate Canada Manitoba member club can have their own clinic the delivery would be very club specific and therefore more worthwhile for Coaches and Club Executive.

When are CanSkate Development and Delivery Clinics held?

CanSkate Development and Delivery Clinics should be held in the earlier part of your CanSkate Season, it is best done prior to your CanSkate session commencing. Clinics are done in half days, approximately 4 hours off ice and 1 hour on ice. Please book early or as soon as possible as dates and clinicians do book up fast.

What Preparations are needed for the CanSkate Development and Delivery Clinics?

Host Club Executive contact the chosen Clinician and provide the Clinician with information of the club's CanSkate programs. Inform them of the number of PA's, Coaches and Club Executive. The Host Club would be responsible for the following:

- Clinician fees **(grants available)
- Setting participants registration fee
- Clinician Contracts (Section Office can provide some assistance)
- Cost of the facility
- Clinician travel expenses
- Advertisement of Clinic
- Snacks
- Clinician hotel accommodations (if necessary)
- Clinician meals
- Any other expenses incurred while hosting the clinic will be the responsibility of the Host.



Note: You may apply for a Sport Manitoba Grant for hosting this event. Please contact your Sport Manitoba Regional Manager for the “Hosting Community/Regional Athlete Skill Development Clinics/Camp” Grant. This **MUST** be submitted to your Sport Manitoba Regional Manager 3-4 weeks prior to your event. This Grant is over and above the Skate Canada Manitoba Clinician Grant.

What criterion must be met?

Hosting Clubs are asked to contact Mary Elliott at the Section Office once the clinic date and clinician has been finalized, with the following information;

- *CanSkate Development and Delivery Clinic Coordinator
- *location of the Clinic
- *date of the Clinic
- *The clinician selected for the clinic
- *Registration form/information poster

A schedule will be developed by the Host Club and the Clinician. Approximate number of hours of ice required should be discussed with your Clinician as to what they require.

The Club will be responsible for contacting the clinician, conducting registration, providing a facility for on and off – ice classes. Three or four on – site volunteers will be required for the day.

CanSkate Development and Delivery Clinic changes/clarifications for 2011-2012 are as follows;

- *Clinics will **ONLY** be Club/individually based – No Region based clinics to be held. The only exception to this is if one coach coaches at multiple clubs then a multi-club clinic can be held with the all of the clubs that the coach coaches at.
- *9 Skate Canada Manitoba grants will be available for clubs to apply for to pay for the clinician fee.
- *to be eligible to apply for the Skate Canada Manitoba grant the club **MUST** have attended one of the 2011 CanSkate LIVE Sessions. If more than one club in a Region applies and is eligible, **ALL** club names will be put into a draw and one club will be selected to receive the grant. Clubs **MUST** recognize that they may be 100% responsible for all costs associated with hosting the clinic. If one or more of the regions do not have any clubs who are eligible to apply for a grant, then **ALL** clubs From **ALL** regions who did not receive a grant would be put into a draw for the remaining grants until all 9 grants have been distributed.

Cancellation/Rescheduling+

In the event that the clinic is cancelled by the club the following fees would be applicable (clubs would be required to pay the clinician). In the event the clinic is cancelled and the club was selected to receive a Skate Canada Manitoba Grant – the club would lose the funding

- *45 days prior to clinic - \$50
- *30 days prior to clinic - \$100
- *15 days prior to clinic - \$150
- *7 days or less prior to clinic - \$250



If the clinician needs to cancel/reschedule the following would apply;

- *Clinician would need to find a replacement (from those eligible to do the clinic)
- *work with the club to reschedule
- *provide to the club all materials that the clinician had prepared specifically for the club for the clinic

+ Prior to cancelling the clinic please contact your clinician and the Section Office so that every effort can be made to hold the clinic.

In order to facilitate planning at the club level and the ability to host a clinic and fund it – **the application for the Skate Canada Manitoba – CanSkate Development and Delivery Clinician Grant is due into the Section Office no later than August 8, 2011.** The notifications of the clubs selected for the Clinician Grants will be August 22, 2011 (this will allow the clubs who didn't receive a grant to decide if they can still afford to host a clinic).

All grants awarded are pending the attendance at one of the CanSkate LIVE sessions.
