



Club Special Initiative Grant

Skate Canada Manitoba has created a club grant program that may be used to support a UNIQUE one time only event that supports the goals of Skate Canada Manitoba and is not normally financially supported by Skate Canada or Skate Canada Manitoba.

The following groups are eligible to apply for the grant; Skate Canada Manitoba Member Clubs, Skating Schools, Region or Skate Canada Manitoba Committee.

Skate Canada Manitoba Section Values are:

Skating is at the heart of all that we do. We are passionate about making a difference in our sport. We do so by living our values everyday.

COLLABORATION – *As partners in the delivery of skating in Manitoba, we generate relevant knowledge to our members in a timely and strategic manner.*

RESPECT. *We make ethical decisions based upon integrity and fairness allowing all individuals to express their opinions.*

INCLUSION. *We provide the opportunity for every participant to be involved in skating for life.*

Submissions for use of these funds must be submitted to the Section Office and include the following information:

- i) Reason for which funding is requested;
- ii) Rationale why funding should be provided;
- iii) Reason why event etc, cannot be funded within the current committee budget;
- iv) Detailed budget for the event etc.

All submissions are subject to the approval of the Skate Canada Manitoba Executive. No funds will be provided or spent until such approval is received.

A maximum of 1 application may be submitted in any one year by an eligible applicant. Joint applications are encouraged.

Applications may be evaluated on the following basis;

- Evidence of or potential to broadly impact Skate Canada Manitoba program participants; increase program participants
- Evidence of sustainability
- Evidence of good planning, sound research

Complete the attached application form in full, include detailed project budget by the approved deadline date.

Applications to be sent out annually by April 1; Deadline date will be annually by June 30; notifications out annually by September 15. Approved Projects to be completed by the following September 1.
