



***NEW* CanSkate Development and Delivery CLINICS for the 2010-2011 Season**

(Former PA Motivational Clinic)

What is the CanSkate Development and Delivery Clinic?

The CanSkate Development and Delivery Clinics are for PA's, Coaches and Club Executive who assist in the delivery of the CanSkate Program in their club. These clinics provide an opportunity to develop teaching methods and program delivery techniques to enhance existing CanSkate Programs and at the same time ensure that the program is being delivered according to the National Standards. The CanSkate Development and Delivery Clinic is an optional program for your Club/Region.

Who leads the CanSkate Development and Delivery Clinics?

Skate Canada Manitoba has approved CanSkate Development and Delivery Clinicians, their bios and contact information is on the Skate Canada Manitoba's website.

Where are the CanSkate Development and Delivery Clinics held?

Rather than one club hosting all the other clubs in the Region, each club may have their own clinic and the delivery would be very club specific and therefore more worthwhile for Coaches and Club Executive to attend.

When are CanSkate Development and Delivery Clinics held?

CanSkate Development and Delivery Clinics are to be held in the earlier part of your CanSkate Season, it is best done prior to your CanSkate session commencing. Clinics are done in half days, approximately 4 hours off ice and 1 hour on ice.



What Preparations are needed for the CanSkate Development and Delivery Clinics?

Host Club executive contact the chosen Clinician and provide the Clinician with information of the club's CanSkate programs. Inform them of the number of PA's, Coaches and Club Executive. The Host Club/Region would be responsible for the following:

- ❑ Clinician fees
- ❑ Setting participants registration fee
- ❑ Clinician Contracts
- ❑ Cost of the facility
- ❑ Clinician travel expenses
- ❑ Advertisement of Clinic
- ❑ Snacks
- ❑ Clinician hotel accommodations (if necessary)
- ❑ Clinician meals
- ❑ Any other expenses incurred while hosting the clinic will be the responsibility of the Host.

Note: You may apply for a Sport Manitoba Grant for hosting this event. Please contact your Sport Manitoba Regional Manager for the "Hosting Community/Regional Athlete Skill Development Clinics/Camp" Grant. This MUST be submitted to your Sport Manitoba Regional Manager 3-4 weeks prior to your event.

What criterion must be met?

Regional Supervisors are asked to contact the Skate Canada Manitoba, Program Coordinator **no later than August 13th, 2010** with the following information if you would like it advertised on the Skate Canada - Manitoba website:

- * CanSkate Development and Delivery Clinic Coordinator
- *location of the Clinic
- *date of the Clinic
- *The clinician selected for the clinic
- *Registration form/information poster

A schedule will be developed by the Host Club/Region and the Clinician. Approximate number of hours of ice required should be discussed with your Clinician as to what they require.

The Region will be responsible for contacting the clinician, conducting registration, providing a facility for on and off – ice classes. Three or four on – site volunteers will be required for the day.
