- identifies and calls correct Levels of Difficulty of the performed elements;
- identifies falls;
- identifies illegal elements;
- identifies the innovative element bonus.
- identifies and deletes additional elements

Following are the minimum recommended qualifications for consideration of new candidates for the position of technical specialist at the Sectional level.

### **SECTIONAL LEVEL TECHNICAL SPECIALIST (recommended qualifications)**

1. Must be a current member of Skate Canada (Associate or Coaching member) at the time of appointment.
2. Must be a former skater – with minimum level of experience at the Divisional/ Challenge/ Jr. Nationals or higher as a competitor, coach and/or judge
3. Must demonstrate an on-going commitment to figure skating through regular activity in the sport
4. Must abide by the officials code of conduct, as published in the Skate Canada rule book
5. Must pass the examination for Sectional Technical Specialist
6. Selection will be made in consideration of the above listed qualifications, anticipated and actual conflicts of interest, and on a needs assessment in consideration of the time and location of competitions in the 2010/11 season.
